

The Bee Keeping

Description: A farmer/beekeeper comes to teach you about the life inside a hive of honeybees. Includes a real slice of the hive to watch them work, a taste of their golden hard-earned treat and equipment to test. Great for all ages and available June-August (sometimes Sept). Also available Sept-Oct and Jan-Feb but without live bees. Can be done indoors or outdoors. Up to 40 participants.

Length: This program starts at one hour but for an additional charge you can add hour(s). We also offer five presentations over a period of five hours at a discounted price.

Price: Prices on all programs vary on time of year, how many (hours) and where you are located. We service NY, NJ, DE, PA and MD. We are in Pennsburg, PA. We typically will travel three hours away.

When will we arrive? When will we leave? We come about 30 min before your “start” time to set up. Due to different ages of audience we will remain till the conclusion of the program, which is approximately one hour. It will take about 20-30 minutes to clean up the program at your facility. Keep in mind we cannot control traffic, but we will try to give you a call if we are going to be late.

What animals do we bring? A slice of our bee’s hive with live bees, but only in the warm months June-August (Sometimes May and Sept). If you do not want bees, please try to request this before delivery date. If you do not you may ask the farmer to keep them in the vehicle.

What you need to know.

A. We are insured and can send you a certificate. If you are tax exempt, we will need copy of your certificate. You can make checks payable to Quiver Farm Projects, Inc. mailed to 3096 Wild Run Road, Pennsburg, PA 18073.

B. When you pay your invoice, you are agreeing to the cancellation and payment policies listed below.

C. You are not scheduled unless you have approved the quote received in your client hub and you are not confirmed for delivery until the full payment policy has been met.

D. We bring honey sticks for everyone to enjoy at the end of the program.

Payment Policy: The 50% deposit is due on booking to hold your date. Remaining balance is due 30 days before delivery. So, if you are booking within 30 days of your program, the total program price is due. If you are paying with a purchase order, we must receive a copy of the purchase order at least 30 days before delivery, please notify us if this is how you plan to pay so we can make the invoice accordingly.

Cancellation Policy: Quiver Farm Projects does not issue refunds; we will reschedule or apply your credit to another program. If you reschedule the program or apply the credit to a different program that is more than 6 months away, then there is a \$50 service fee that will be due 30 days before delivery.

If canceling within 30 days of delivery, there is a cancellation charge equal to 50% of your total program price. If canceling due to weather, we must be notified before the farmer leaves the farm or there will be driver’s fee varying in cost depending on distance.

If there is any issue with the above policies, please ask to speak to the office manager, please do not confront or ask another farmer on delivery day or other office personnel when scheduling.
